


As a not for profit, eco-social enterprise, we have spent 16 years developing education, training, research and services in the three realms of practice within Applied Ecopsychology. These realms are Nature, Health and Wellbeing, Ecotherapy and Eco Depth Practice. As a community interest company (CIC) we have also been actively creating and connecting a community of practice that can support the growth and development of these nature based approaches. Our main purpose is to support the healing of separation in ourself, our communities and with the rest of nature and find ways to make this happen.

As Natural Academy CIC we have established our home base at Ham Green House and Land near Bristol, which is owned by Penny Brohn UK a holistic health charity. Ham Green is from the Old English and means Green Home which feels appropriate to our work here. We have been raising money to invest in the land and spaces to secure these for the long term. This is so that they can be in trust for the purpose above. We have already funded the long term lease and roundhouse build on one acre of beautiful wild land called SkyView but to fully open the space to people and nature we need to secure the 5 acres of land next to this. We are calling the centre we are developing Ham Green Outdoor Centre and we want it to continue to be a place for people and nature, have indoor spaces for training, therapy and health, outdoor classrooms/safe sheltered spaces, wilder spaces, and places of tranquillity for nature connectedness. This site will continue the work of Natural Academy and the Natural Institute (research and evaluation), delivering, training and researching our models of practice in applied ecopsychology.

From 2025-2028 we want to further establish the Ham Green Outdoor Centre as a national centre for the vital and emerging field of study and practice within Applied Ecopsychology. We will do this by further applying the development cycle opposite.

In order to make this happen we need to secure Lake Side, 5 Acres of land, for this purpose and build a team that can engage with communities, for health and education, and also rewild and conserve the precious, beautiful spaces for the natural world.



Ham Green Outdoor Centre A National Hub For Our Community of Practice

Our purpose as a CIC is enabling and supporting our community of practice to develop, deliver and grow effective and evidence informed nature-based interventions. These interventions are reciprocal in that they help people and the rest of nature, recover, regenerate and flourish.

We have now over 500 people in our community of practice and we offer ongoing CPD, supervision, mentoring and community events.

We are also working with larger organisations such as the NHS, Natural England, Wildlife Trusts and in the VCSE sector to enable nature-based practice to emerge more fully.

We have Dwell and Nest, within Ham Green House, as indoor health and education spaces. These open to the beautiful 4 acre wellbeing garden, they are accessible to all, warm, comfortable and inviting.



Across the lane from the House we have developed SkyView which is our working outdoor space with a beautiful roundhouse and compost toilets and direct access to wilder land. We have raised money for a 125 year lease to secure this land and spaces for people and nature.



finding the resources
